- Becoming involved in local community problems, your activity to help those who are defenseless, to promote cultural and social growth in the community
- And finally keep in mind that play, joy, happiness are inalienable assets shared by everyone and that each one of us has the duty to defend.

### But what is a club?

It's a not for profit group made up of people who want to promote cultural, recreational and social action.

### And How Does It Work?

- The Charter is the organization's first official act
- The Statute is that set of rules that regulate the club's life; they apply to all members
- The Membership Card allows you to attend all events, activities and to participate in the club's daily life, as well as that of the national organization,
- The Assembly is made up by the club's members; it chooses the yearly program, votes the budget, elects the executive committee
- The Executive Committee puts in practice the program, elects the club's president, and carries out the Assembly's programmatic mandate,
- The President, as established by Italian laws, is also the club's legal representative.

### When can a club not be started?

A club is not a store or a coffee shop, but the concerted effort of a group of people who, without any profit motive, come together to develop their common interests, therefore there are no owners or founding members (i.e. individuals with special privileges)

Instead it's possible by following the rules set by the legislature, to work in a club and receive compensation for it.

If you start a club and join Arci, support, services and technical advice will always be available to you.
